



In Memoriam

Naioma Walberg

1957-2016

Founder of the Rocky Mountain Antiquarian Book Fair in 1985

In 1985, a 28-year-old bookseller named Naioma Walberg, who had never attended a book fair, decided that Denver should have one. She and her mother hand-addressed invitations to 400 prospective exhibitors and rented the Grand Ballroom of the Fairmont Hotel. She enlisted all her relatives and those of her husband Brad. It was a huge success, with booksellers from all over North America and 1500 paying customers.

It is my sad duty to tell you that Naioma died of a massive heart attack June 13 at a youthful 59 years. Over the years she created the Denver Book Mall, first in a small location and then a very large shop at 32 Broadway, which broke up only because the building was sold. (It's a restaurant now.)

Eventually she decided she needed a "real job" with benefits and worked at the Parker Public Library in the Douglas County system. It was a long commute, but she continued to live in North Denver with Brad and his amazing garden. And she kept thinking up book projects. She helped me contact under-funded public libraries that could take as donations to their inventories 3,000 books about Colorado culled from a private collection.

I realize this is very personal, but Brad told me she did not want to have a funeral or even an announcement. Personally, I could not allow her passing be ignored.
